

Scranton City Council Minutes
October 6, 2009

The Scranton City Council met in special session on Tuesday, October 6, 2009 for the purpose of holding a public forum regarding the possible acquisition of the former Scranton School building. Mayor Rudolph called the meeting to order at 7:03 PM. A motion was made by Jacobsen, seconded by Reck to approve the agenda. APVA/MC

Mayor Rudolph presented a Power Point presentation that provided information on possible uses of the building, activities that have been held in the building over the past year, concerns with the acquisition, heating and cooling estimates and possible developments in Scranton. After the presentation Mayor Rudolph read written comments. Two of the four were from students. Several speakers, both adults and children, made comments regarding the possible acquisition. No action was taken at the meeting.

At 7:40 PM Council members Walker and Wright, along with several persons from the audience, left due to being paged out on a fire call.
